





Punjani Charitable Trust, originating from Canada with a branch in United Kingdom(UK), took the initiative in 2023 to establish a registered NGO in Tanzania under the name "Punjani Charitable Trust Tanzania." This entity was created to facilitate and oversee their charitable endeavors within the country.

Punjani Charitable Trust Tanzania as a Diaspora is proud to announce its contribution towards the development of Tanzania by funding a groundbreaking project focused on IT upskilling training and development. The project aims to provide scholarships, subsidize training costs, develop curricula, and promote the use of Learning Management Systems (LMS) in colleges and secondary schools. This initiative is in line with the government's vision to advance technology and cultivate a skilled workforce in Tanzania.

Punjani Charitable Trust Tanzania (PCT) sponsored JR Institute of Information Technology (JRIIT) to open centre in Dar es Salaam which will be facilitating courses in domain of Data Science, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning (ML), Cybersecurity, Virtual reality/Augmented reality (VR/AR) and Multi-Media and Production.

In April 2023, the journey of Punjani Charitable Trust-Tanzania (PCT) began with the registration process and legal formalities, laying the foundation for our mission. On June 19th, we celebrated our soft launch, marking a significant step forward. During the launch event, Punjani Charitable Trust-Tanzania (PCT) had the honour of awarding scholarships to 48 deserving individuals, including participants from esteemed government institutions such as the College of Business Education and the Dar es Salaam Institute of Technology. These scholarships facilitated their enrolment in UCAM University-Spain's prestigious programs, spanning disciplines such as Advanced Data Science, Cybersecurity, Postgraduate (PG) Diploma in Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning, Computer Vision, Business Intelligence, and Natural Language Processing. From the outset, our commitment to education has been unwavering. We started with the inaugural Digital Literacy course, welcoming four eager students. This was our first batch at the centre. Since then, our impact has grown exponentially, and we have evolved significantly. Today, our program includes Digital Media, Digital literacy, English course, and we have integrated courses from our esteemed partner, Cisco Networking Academy these includes Introduction to Cybersecurity, Data Science & Analytics, Network Technician, Operating System, and Hardware catering to the diverse educational needs of our community.

Within just one year, we've trained and empowered 584 participants, equipping them with invaluable skills for the modern workforce.

The impact of our programs extends beyond the classroom, graduates successfully securing employment and others leveraging their newfound knowledge to enhance their professional capabilities in their current roles.
